Most populous First Nation in BC; pop 5000









Centred in the Cowichan valley, SE Vancouver Island







Cowichan Tribes: young population

... looking for opportunities

Socioeconomic profile:

- majority of population < 34 years of age
- high unemployment
- high reliance on social assistance
- still low rates of high school graduation



Median incomes significantly lower
