- K4F – Clinton (Issued June 9th, 2014)

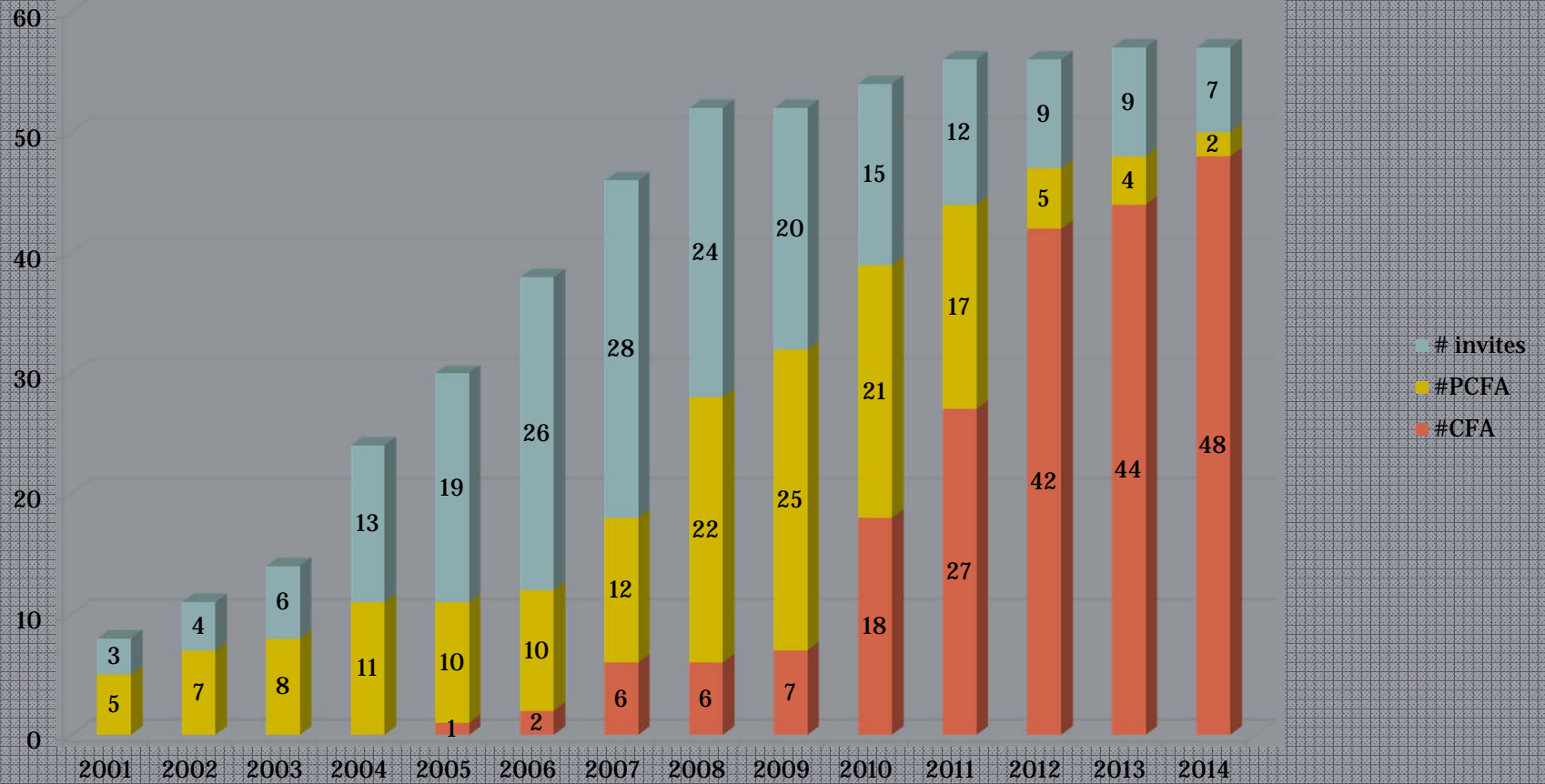
- **PCFAs converted to long term CFAs**

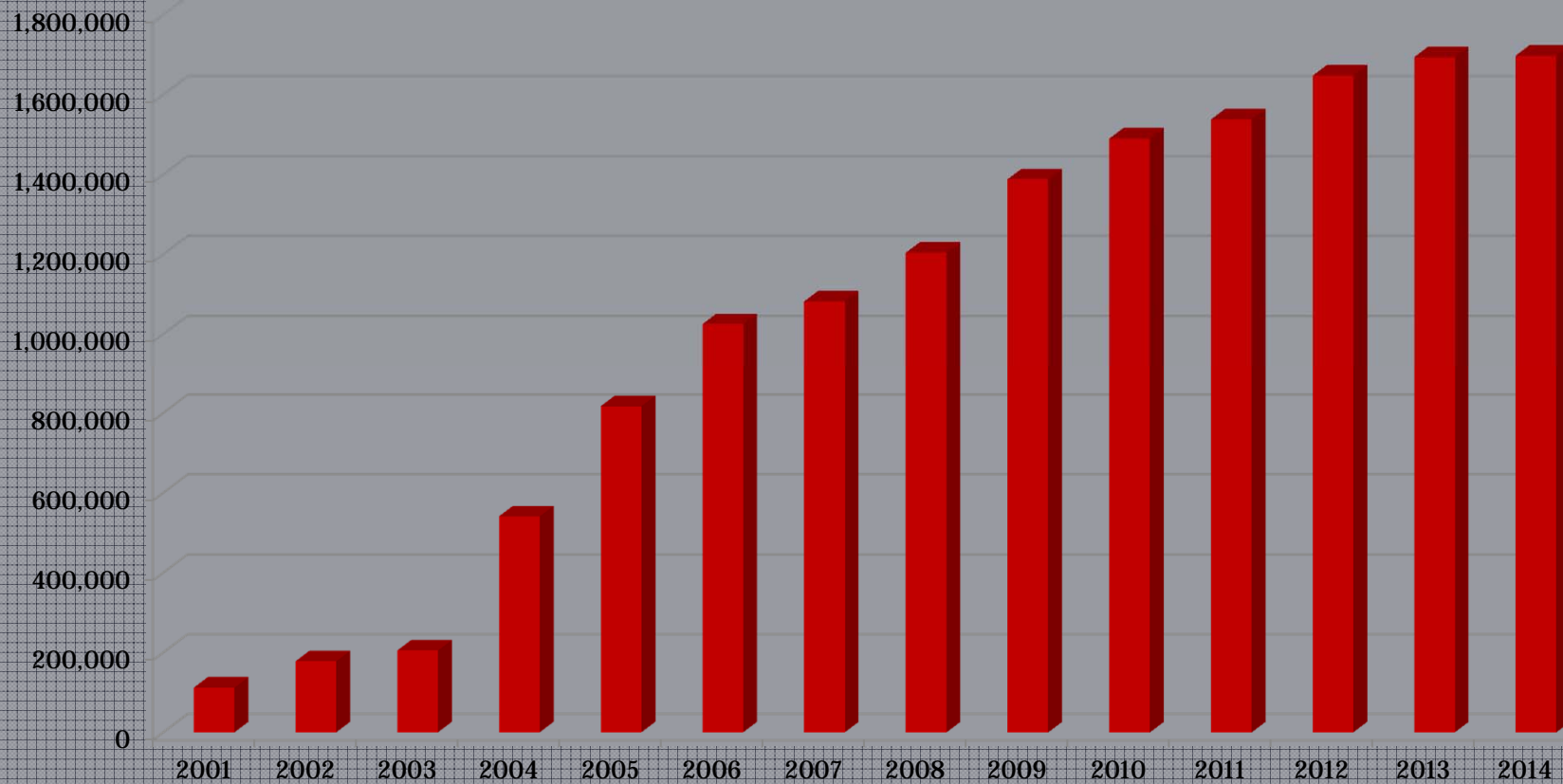
EXPANSION (#s)

Planned/ Apportioned CFA



- Potential for up to 161 400 m³/yr that could be added to the program (up to 9 more CFAs).
- Total AAC could be 1.9 million m³/yr in issued CFAs sometime in the future.

Other Accomplishments



- 1-CP over CFAs implemented provincially September of 2012. Presently 16 CFAs with 1-CP...and growing.
- Forest Act s. 49.1 recently amended to allow DM to issue FUP with licensee's permission.

Volume to Area



- **Engagement occurred during April & May, 2014.**
- **Report to Minister Thomson due June 30th.**

BCTS opportunities update



- **Review of BCTS' role and effectiveness**
- **An objective to focus on business-to-business with 3rd party partners and customers where it makes business sense**
- **Form more durable relationships, subject to enabling legislation**
