Achievements in 2012



- **Issued CFAs – 2012**
 - Little Prairie Community Forest (Chetwynd)
- **PCFAs converted to long term CFAs - 2012**
 - Tla'amin Timber Products Ltd. (Sliammon)
 - Valemont Community Forest Company Ltd. (Valemont) and
 - Eniyud Community Forests Ltd. (Alexis Creek and Tatla)
- **New CFA Invitations – 2012**
 - Burns Lake Communities (Village, Regional District and 6 FNs)

Achievements in 2013 (to date)



- **Issued CFAs – 2013**
 - Monashee Community Forest LLP (Lumby and Splats'in)
- **PCFAs converted to long term CFAs - 2013**
 - Dungate (Houston)
- **New CFA Invitations – 2013**
 - Village of Fraser Lake (45 000 m³/yr.) and promise to invite Vanderhoof (45 000 m³/yr.)

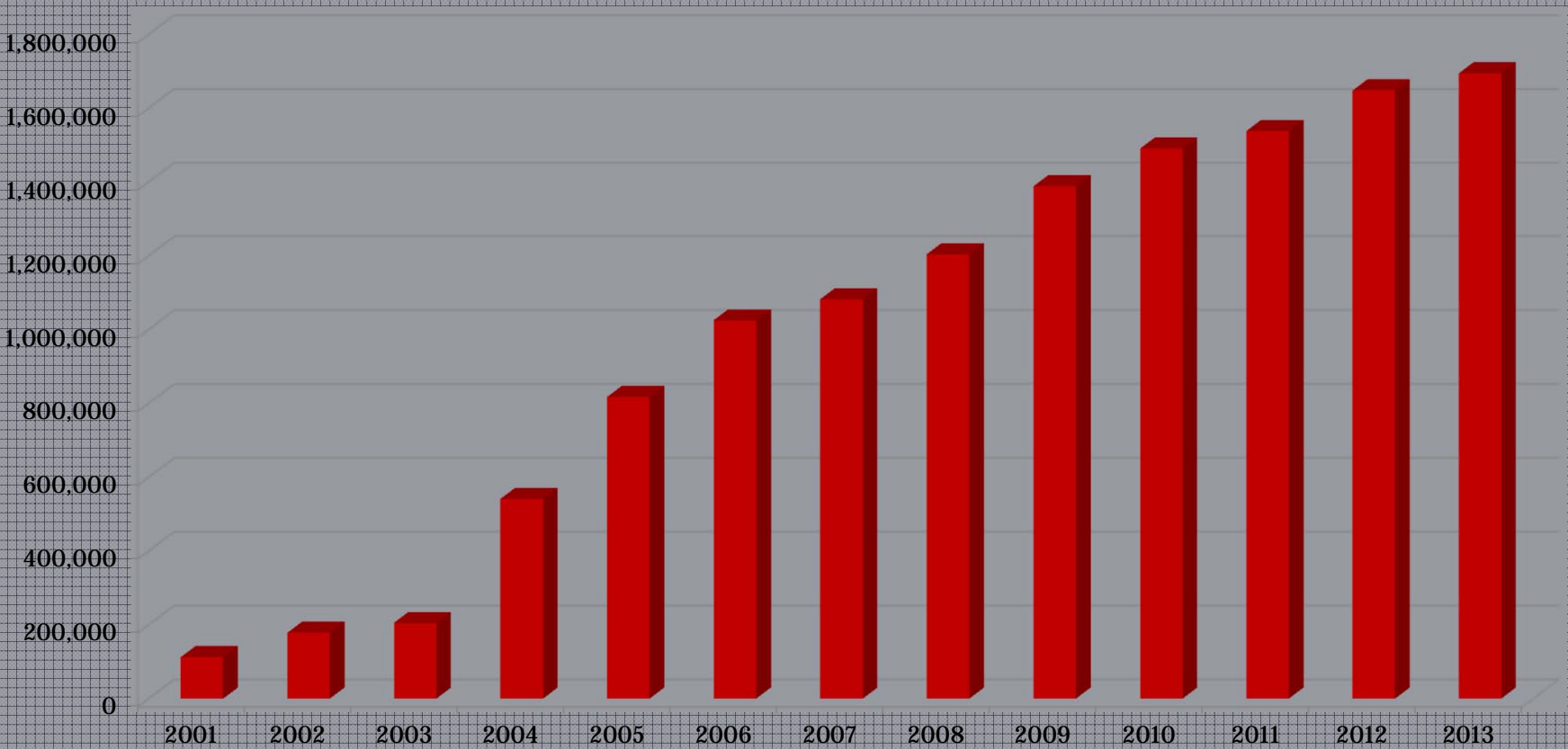
EXPANSION (#s)

Planned/ Apportioned CFA



- Potential for up to 175 400 m³/yr that could be added to the program (expansion of 2 existing CFAs and up to 9 more CFAs)
- Total AAC could be 1.9 million m³/yr in CFAs sometime in the future

Other Accomplishments



- **One CP over CFAs implemented provincially September of 2012**
- **Subject to DM's approval:**
 - Approved FSP in place;
 - CP on tabular rates; and,
 - FN consultation has occurred.

Future



- Continue to implement the One CP
 - Utilize volume allocated to program
 - Hire a new Tenures Forester (Dave Haley retired)
 - Division support of WoodSourceBC
 - Continue collaborative work with BCCFA via monthly conference calls
