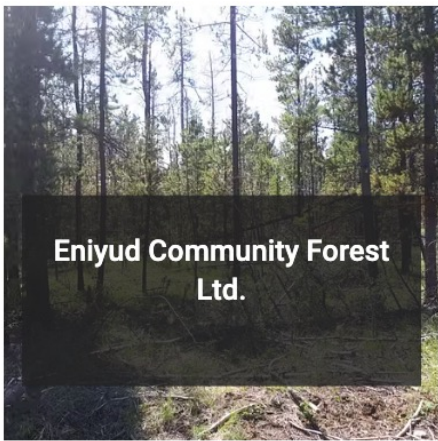
Community Forest Indicator #13 Proactive Wildfire Management

- 77% have collaborated with their local government on wildfire planning and mitigation
- \$ 8 million worth of CF funded projects to date, average \$389 K.
- \$16.3 million from outside sources to date
- Treated 7,600 Ha to date, average 420 Ha.
- Last year – community forests invested over \$2 million and managed another \$4 million from provincial and federal govts.

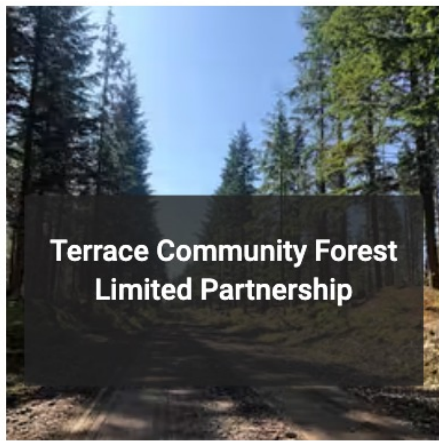
Wildfire Risk Reduction Funding for Community Forests

- Under the Economic Recovery Initiative, approximately \$5 million was allocated to the BCCFA to create or stimulate employment opportunities in 15 rural communities through Crown Land WRR projects.
- The BCCFA collaborated with BCWS to build and implement this program.
